Australian Catholic Super provides a brief responsible investment summary document wherein they outline the UNPRI and state they are "committed to responsible investment." There is no clear policy on ESG issues and they direct individuals with an interest towards their SRI option. They exclude tobacco and cluster munitions. ¹
